# 5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

#### 5.1 Compliance

All competing vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual.

Roll Cage is not mandatory for this event!

<u>Uncaged cars</u> are limited to a maximum of 2500cc engine capacity and no forced induction (Turbo / Supercharger)

#### 5.2 Classes

Vehicles will be divided into the following classes: Class A 0 – 1300cc Class B 1301cc – 1600cc Class C 1601cc and over Class D All 4wd Vehicles Class XC - Crosscars

#### 6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for scrutineering.
