3. The Event

- 3.1 Venue: Scroggs Hill Road, Brighton.
- 3.2 Surface: Sealed approx. 2.5km
- 3.3 Documentation and Scrutineering: 9.00am – 10.00am at the OSCC Van.
- 3.4 Drivers Briefing: 10.15am at the OSCC Van.
- 3.5 Runs: There will be up to 4 timed runs, time permitting. The overall result will be taken from the results of the completed official runs.
- 3.6 There will be 2 chicanes made of road cones. A 5 second time penalty maybe applied for cones knocked over.

4. Entries

- 4.1 **Fees:** Entry Fee \$80, Entries accepted on the day at the OSCC Van.
- 4.2 **Competitor Requirements:**
Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms competitors are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.

Licence Requirements:

Drivers shall hold a Club Sport or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competitors Licence and be a member of any Motorsport NZ affiliated club.

5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- 5.1 **Compliance**
All competing vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A of the current Motorsport Manual. Roll Cage Mandatory.
- 5.2 **Classes**
Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
 - Class A 0 – 1300cc
 - Class B 1301cc – 1600cc
 - Class C 1601cc and over
 - Class D All 4wd Vehicles

6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for scrutineering.
